

ADDENDUM #4 RFQ 24-001

Bowden Street Tank Painting and Inspection

This addendum is being issued to address questions submitted on RFQ 24-001

- Q1. Is it a containment required during the process of exterior sandblasting?
- A1. We are specifying methods; we are simply saying they will be responsible for damage caused (2.3). Meanwhile the second question brings up "approach to the project" They could mention that they are containing the dust and overspray in their approach and score some points.
- Q2. Could the city provide a price sheet on this bid?
- A2. We are really asking for a proposal not a simple bid. Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:
- 5.2 Responses to this RFQ will be scored according to the following selection criteria:
- 5.2.1 Overall Cost & Pricing 50 Points
- 5.2.2 Approach to Project 20 Points
- 5.2.3 Company Background 20 Points
- 5.2.4 References 10 Points
- Q3. Will we need to provide a bid bond which is what is turned in with a bid? If we do have to provide a bid bond, can you tell me if it will be a 5% or 10% bond?
- A3. The Public Works Construction Law requires all bidders to submit bid bonds for all public works construction contracts with estimated bids or proposals over \$100,000. The bid bond must be in an amount equal to 5% of the total contract amount. No bid or proposal shall be considered to be complete unless a bid bond has been submitted. O.C.G.A. § 36-91-50(d).

This addendum should be signed and returned with your proposal. Failure to do so may result in the proposal being non-responsive.
